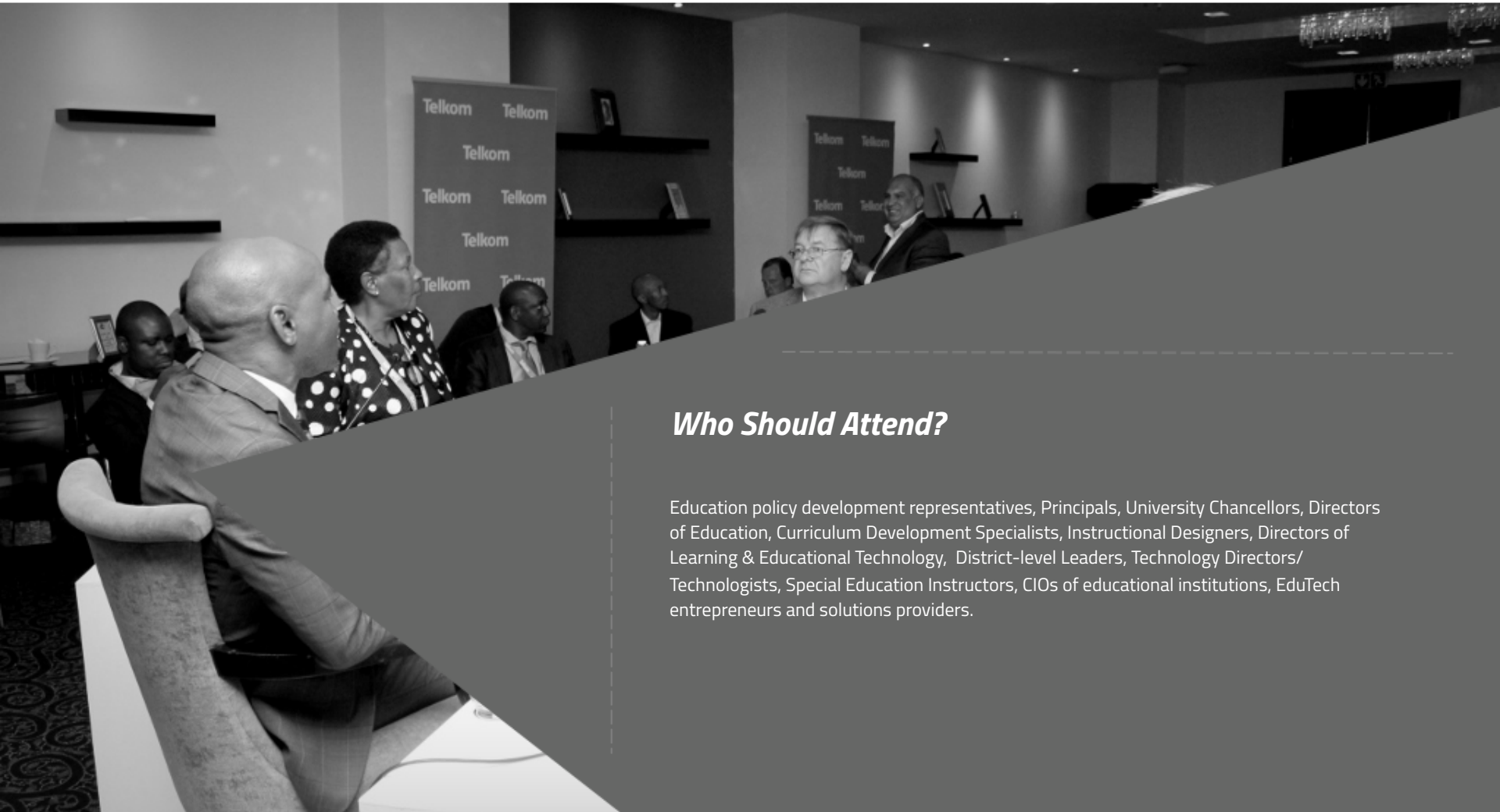
The Format:

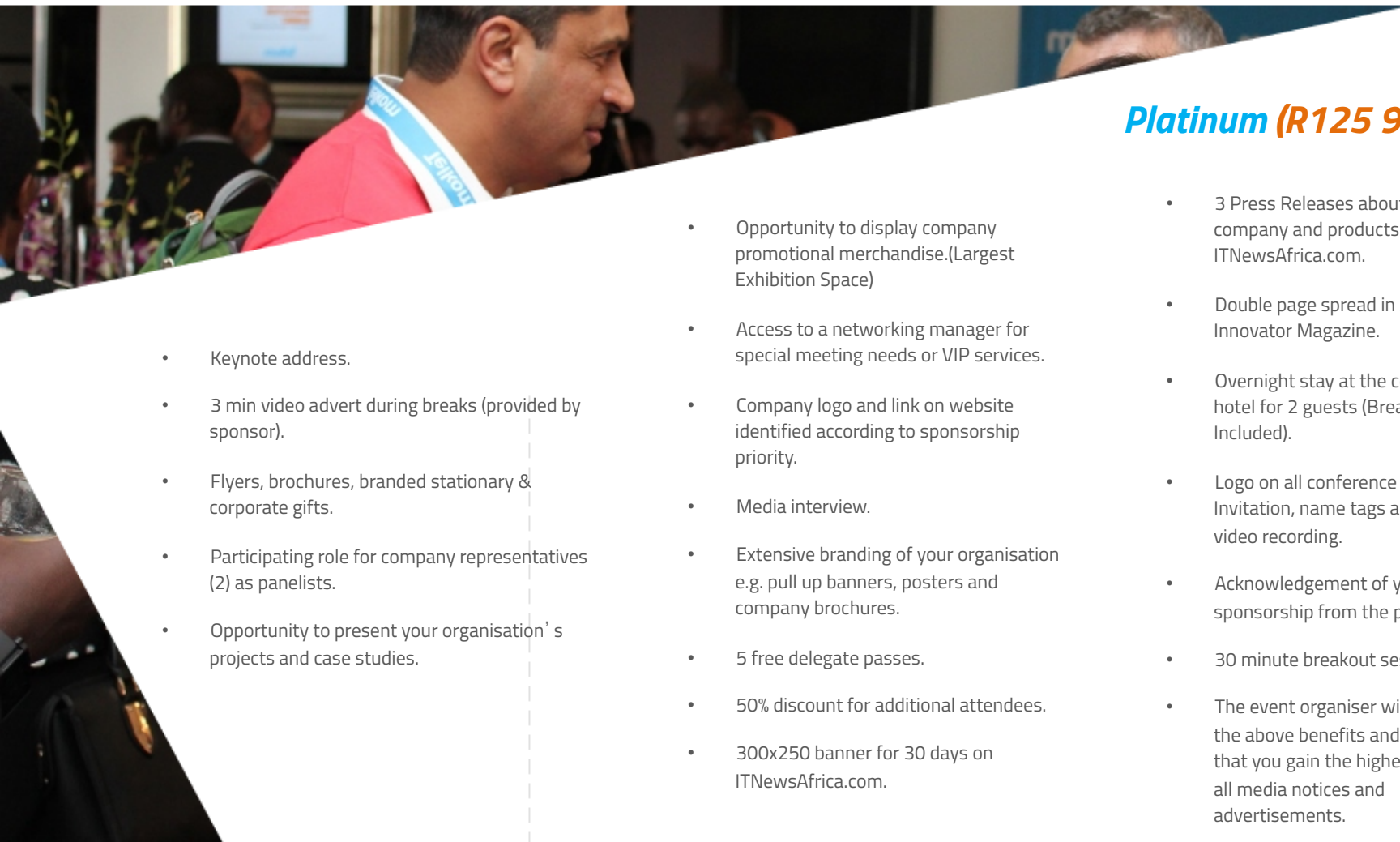

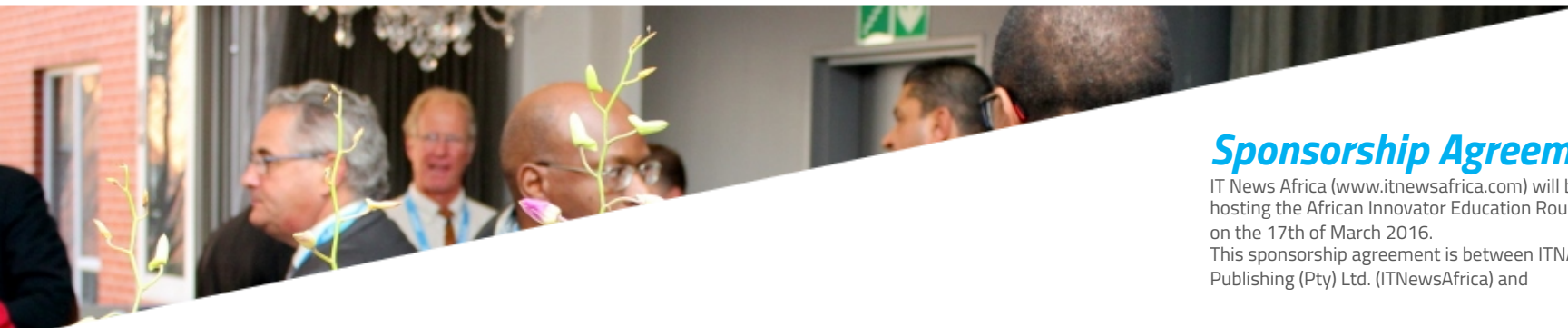

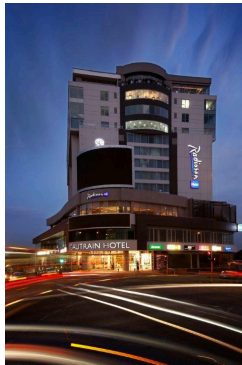

You, the sponsor ("Sponsor") agree to abide by the terms and conditions set forth in this agreement ("Agreement"). This Agreement will be fully binding between the parties.

2. Payment and Terms. Sponsorship packages will be released on a first come first-served basis. Sponsorships to be paid by check will be held for 10 days, and then released back for sale if payment is not received. ITNA reserves the right to deny exhibitors access to the conference if payment in full is not received within two weeks of agreement. Sponsor may cancel its participation in the African Innovator Round Tables conference, but due to the limited number of sponsorship slots allocated for the event, Sponsorship fees are non-refundable and will be allocated to one of our other events during the year. Without limiting its rights to the foregoing, ITNA reserves the right to prohibit sponsors from participation in the conference if payment is not received prior to the Conference.

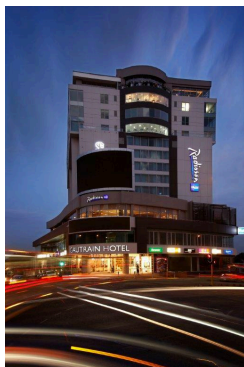

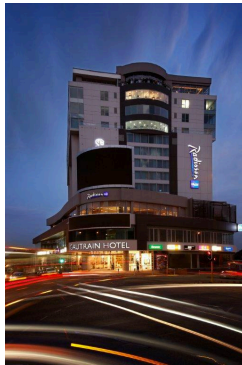
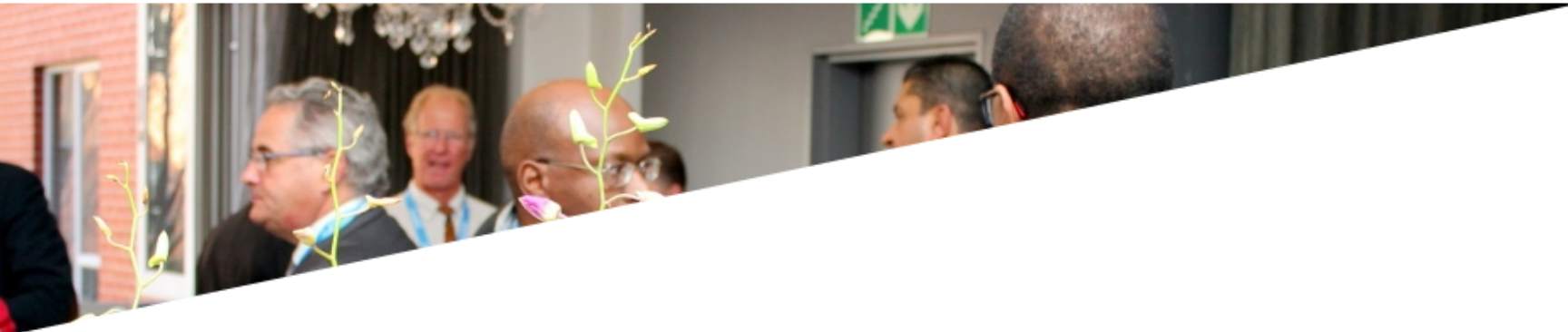
